#### Challenge

Metro Nashville Public Schools (MNPS), one of Tennessee's largest school districts, faced growing challenges in keeping its educational technology operations efficient. #### Solution

In May 2024, MNPS adopted Veracity's Technology Management System to modernize its edtech infrastructure.
